Blood Sacrifice at Exodus-

Ex. 12:13 “And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye *are*: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy *you*, when I smite the land of Egypt.”



Isaiah 53:3-4

4. This relationship with Jesus is described as a fruitful tree-

Mt. 7:16-19 “You shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?”



4. Mt. 7:19-20

“Every tree that brings not forth good fruit is cut down, and cast into the fire, by their fruits you shall know them.”



4. This relationship with Jesus is described as a fruitful tree-

Mt. 7:17-18 Even so every good tree brings forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree brings forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.



5. This relationship is described as a new house-temple:

“Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?” (1 Cor. 3:16)






